Installation: Copy the KEYMACRO.VBE file to the system's HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\F-Secure\Anti-Virus registry key (HKEY LOCAL MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\F-Secure\Anti-Virus). Copy the KEYMACRO.DLL file to the system's HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\F-Secure\Anti-Virus\System key (HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Microsoft\F-Secure\Anti-Virus\System). Since these are the most popular emailing applications on the market, W32/Warpigs.B worm is able to spread rapidly, making it one of the most harmful worms ever discovered. It infects all computers on a network and as the worm spreads it enters computers at random and infects the drives and services of the infected computers. In infected computers it spreads with the help of the Outlook email client. In addition, it can be used by Trojans that are installed in infected computers in order to distribute more malicious programs. W32/Warpigs.B worm is dangerous as it is able to delete all the data in the infected computer, including data and information stored in all active drives and system components. It may also launch DDoS attacks (Distributed Denial of Service) and send copies of the worm to all addresses stored in the infected computer's address book. In addition, the worm is able to spread itself through networks, so even though it has been discovered that it can only infect computers with Microsoft Office Outlook installed, it is advisable to remove it from all computers that belong to a local network.
